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STRENGTHS

- ◉ Comprehensive overview of different stakeholders and all point of views
- ◉ Increasing/improving negotiation skills
- ◉ Broadening one's awareness of other perspectives
- ◉ Increasing tolerance towards other stakeholders
- ◉ Positive starting point for solving the complex issue

WEAKNESSES

- ◉ Not beneficial with a small group - the method benefits best from larger number of participants coming from different interest groups
- ◉ In real life conflict situations there is always a group that has a bigger say over the others
- ◉ Method can fail without a good facilitator
- ◉ Language barrier might come an obstacle in effective implementation of the exercise

OPPORTUNITIES

- ◉ Opening interaction with other interest groups
- ◉ Can be applied in various conflict situations
- ◉ Integrating minority and socially disadvantaged groups
- ◉ Politicians get to hear the views of their electorate
- ◉ Good rehearsal for an important meeting with higher authorities
- ◉ Improving one's self-confidence and presentation skills
- ◉ Learning about other people's views and their strengths

THREATS

- ◉ Can lead to more serious social conflicts and heated arguments
- ◉ Misinterpretation/misunderstanding of other perspectives
- ◉ The exercise can lead to a worse outcome than the initial situation
- ◉ False perception of the reality when not all the stakeholders are present
- ◉ Politisation of stakeholders - skewing the real situation
