Selection Process of the Participants

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1. MOBILITY AND NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS.

Throughout the course of the project, adult learners and teachers/trainers/staff from your organisation will take part in the various activities listed in the programme of work. These activities can be divided between those taking place at local level and those involving the mobility of participants.

1.1. What is a mobility?

It is a visit by one person from your organisation to a partner organisation in another country. Mobilities are essentially partnership mobility activities to discuss progress of the project, plan future activities and gain an insight into the context of the hosting organisation. Please note that the mobilities must be undertaken by people who are working or learning in your organisation.

Also, as you have received a grant for 24 mobilities, at least **16 different adult learners** from your organisation must take part in the mobilities. Failure to involve the required number of different learners in the mobilities would result in a significant reduction in your grant at the end of the project. However, teachers/trainers/staff or staff accompanying the adult learners can participate in more than one mobility activity abroad.

1.2. Number of participants.

As a reminder, the table below indicates what are the planned number of participants per organisation.

You may distribute the 24 mobilities as you wish throughout the 6 meetings (you are not using any mobility when hosting the meeting).

2. CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF ADULT LEARNERS AND TEACHERS/TRAINERS/STAFF WHO WILL TAKE PART IN THE ACTIVITIES OF THE PARTNERSHIP.

2.1. Criteria for the selection of adult learners who will take part in the activities of the partnership.

Within Grundtvig, the definition of an 'adult' is a person over 25 or young people below that age who are no longer undergoing initial education within the formal school or higher education.

Therefore, we kindly ask you to apply the following criteria when selecting the adult learners taking part in the activities:

- To be over 18 years old (over 25 or between 18 and 25 who are no longer undergoing initial education within the formal school or higher education);
- To prioritise and encourage the participation of people from disadvantaged social groups. This could include those with special needs, older learners, groups facing socio-economic disadvantage, those with few or no formal qualifications, travellers, refugees, migrant workers, those with disabilities, minority ethnic groups, individuals living in rural or deprived inner city areas, those unemployed, offenders and ex-offenders...
- To encourage gender balance;
- To have an open and transparent selection process.

Adult learners **cannot** be:

- children/pupils under 16 years old; or
- students or undergraduates.

2.2. Criteria for the selection of teachers/trainers/staff who will take part in the activities of the partnership.

Teachers/trainers/staff accompanying adult learners can include teachers, trainers, education or project managers, adult education counsellors...

When selecting the teachers please take the following criteria into considerations:

- They must be 18 or over;
- They must have a good command of English, written and spoken;
- They must be willing to work and support the adult learners in particular those from disadvantaged social group.
